Eligibility: This meet is open to all swimmers registered with USA Swimming and will be conducted according to current USA Swimming Rules & Regulations. The age of the swimmer on the first day of the meet will determine the age group of competition. The meet director reserves the right to limit entries to conform with MA rules. Notification will be provided to swimmers teams concerning limitation or elimination of any heats/events. Meet fees will be refunded to teams/swimmers who do not participate in any event due to limitations.

Rules: Current USA and Middle Atlantic LSC rules will govern the meet. The whistle start and no recall false start rules will be in use. USA Swimming/Middle Atlantic Swimming Safety Guidelines and warm-up procedures will be in effect for the entire meet. Only currently credentialed coaches, USA Swimming registered athletes and meet personnel will be permitted on deck.

'Fly-over' starts will be used at this meet. All swimmers (except for Backstroke starts) should remain in the water at the completion of their race until the next heat has begun.

Entries: Swimmers may enter a maximum of 5 (five) individual events per day. Penalties will be imposed upon any swimmer when any coach, parent, swimmer enters any time other than the swimmer's best time for any event and could result in the swimmer's suspension from competition for a minimum of three months, but not more than one year. Further violation by a coach, parents or swimmer could result in that person being forbidden to participate in or attending USA Swimming functions.

Deck Access: Deck access will be limited to coaches, officials and essential meet personnel displaying proper current credentials

Bulkhead Safety: Any swimmer observed swimming **under or through the bulkhead** by an Official or Safety Monitor at the meet will be disqualified from that swimmer's next individual event or from the remainder of the meet, as determined by the Meet Referee. This policy will be strictly enforced. **Only officials are allowed on the bulkhead during the meet.**

Entry fee: \$4.00 per individual event, make checks payable to: Central Bucks Community School.

Entries due: All entries must be received by **February 10**, 2012. No late or phone entries will be accepted.

Facility: Central Bucks South High School, 1100 Folly Road, Warrington, PA. An 8 lane, 25 yard pool with electronic timing, judging system and 8 lane readout scoreboard. Depth of the pool at the starting end is 5' and the turn end is 7'. 20 yard Warm-up/Warm-down pool will be open during the entire meet. Snack bar will be available.

Directions:

From 611 N- Make a left onto Bristol Rd. At the 1st light make a left onto Folly Rd. The school is on your right.

From 611 S – Make a right onto Bristol Rd. and then follow the directions above.

Program & Admission: \$5 program & admission per session (no charge for children under 12).

Entry Information: All entries must be filled out on the official entry blank OR entries must be sent electronically. (If you have Hy-Tek Team Manager, submit a printout of the meet entries by swimmer.) You must complete the summary form and mail with the entry whether you use the disk entry or the non-computer entry form. A club contact person must be listed on the entry summary form. As per Middle Atlantic Swimming Rules, a \$15 per swimmer fee will be charged to all entries submitted on paper rather than electronically. An additional \$25 per swimmer fee will be charged to any team submitting manual entries for more than 5 swimmers. We have information on the final page of this information about a Hy Tek product that is free (TM Lite) This product will assist you in completing an electronic entry. Athletes with Disabilities: Swimmers with a disability are welcome to enter this meet. The coach or team entry person must alert the meet director and the meet referee as to the need for any special accommodations or seeding arrangements at the time the entry is submitted.

Start Times:

Saturday Morning - 12&Under

Warm-up – 7:30am, Meet Starts – 8:30am

Saturday Distance:

Warm-up – in warm-up pool, Meet Starts – no earlier than 12:30

Saturday Afternoon – 13 & Over

Warm-up – no earlier than 2:00pm, Meet Starts – no earlier than 2:50

Sunday Morning – 12 & Under

Warm-up – 7:30am, Meet Starts – 8:30am

Sunday IM's:

Warm-up – in warm-up pool, Meet Starts – no earlier than 12:30

Sunday Afternoon – 13 and Over

Warm-up – no earlier than 2:00pm, Meet Starts – no earlier than 2:50

Warm-up Rules: All MA and USA Swimming safety regulations will be in effect. All entries into the pool during the warm-up session will be feet first. The first 45 minutes of each warm-up will be circle swimming, officials will then designate sprint lanes during the last 15 minutes of each session.

Any changes will be posted on the Middle Atlantic web site www.maswim.org.

Warm-ups will be open. The 20 yard diving well will be available for warm-up and warm-down during the meet.

Seeding: All events with the exception of the 500 free (9-18), 400 IM (9-18), 200 free (9-12) and 200 IM (9-12) are pre-seeded timed finals.

Check In: A Positive Check-in is required for the 500 Free (9-18), 400 IM (9-18), 200 Free (9-12) and the 200 IM (9-12). Positive Check-in for these events will close at the beginning of warm-ups.

Any swimmer who does not swim an event for which they have positively checked in will be barred from their next individual event

Deck Entries: Subject to space availability, deck entries will be accepted on the day of the meet, (prior to the start of each session, if applicable) at the cost of \$8.00 per event. **Swimmers not already entered in the meet must provide proof of current USA Swimming registration.** Deck entered swimmers will compete unofficially. You must see the meet director prior to the start of the meet if you wish to deck enter a swimmer.

Swimmer without a Coach: Any swimmer who does not have a coach should see the meet referee before warm-ups.

On Site Registration: *Unregistered swimmers may register on deck at this meet by turning in the athlete registration form and payment to the Meet Director. The cost of registering on deck is double the normal fee (\$120 per swimmer for 2011-12 registration). This applies to all swimmers attached to a club.*

Racing Start Certification: Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Pool Certification: The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4).

Water Depth: The water depth at the start end is 5 feet and is 7 feet at the turn end.

Awards: Awards are presented for each event based on the entry time, not on the time swum during the meet. For example, a swimmer entered into an event with an "A" time or above is eligible to receive a "A" award. A swimmer entered into the meet with a "BB" time is eligible to receive a "BB" award. Swimmers entered into the meet with a time below a "BB" or as "no time" will be eligible to receive a "C" award.

Deck entered swims are not be eligible for awards. In the 12 & Under 500 Free and 200 IM, the 9-10 & 11-12 age groups will be swum together but will be awarded separately. In the Senior 500 Free and 400 IM the 13-14 age group will be awarded separately. Seniors will not receive awards.

The meet host can create TM Lite product CDs to distribute to the participating teams or purchase additional TM Lite CDs from our Sales Office. The participating teams can also download and install TM Lite right from our web site - [Click Here](#) to download TM Lite.

TEAM MANAGER Lite is basically **TEAM MANAGER** with the following features enabled:

- * Standard Set-Up and Options Features
- * Enter Teams, Athletes, Relays, Meets and Browsers
- * Specifying Meet Entry Custom Times by Event or by Name
- * Import of Meet Events from a MEET MANAGER Database
- * Export of Meet Entries to send to the meet host by diskette or over the Internet
- * Meet Entry Report
